Approve Agreement with United States Forest Service

### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an Agreement with United States Forest Service for patrol services on Forest Service land, effective as of the date of the last signature and through September 30, 2016.
- 2. Approve the Operating Plan to the Agreement for up to \$50,000, effective the date of the last signature and through September 30, 2012.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign four copies of the Agreement.

#### SUMMARY:

This is a five-year cooperative law enforcement agreement that includes an Annual Operating Plan (Exhibit A), which allocates \$50,000 for reimbursement of salaries and benefits for Sheriff's deputies. The Annual Operating Plan will be renewed each year pending funding availability. The Forest Service determines the reimbursement amount each year.

The scope of work includes basic law enforcement services provided by two Sheriff's deputies in remote mountainous areas of eastern Tulare County. In addition, there is a provision to reimburse the County for deputy services during extraordinary situations, such as fire emergencies and drug enforcement activities.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

USFS will pay \$50,000 to defray Sheriff staffing costs for the basic law enforcement services. Any additional expenditures will be absorbed in the Sheriff's FY 2011/2012 operating budget.

#### **LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to effectively and fairly investigate arrest, prosecute and punish individuals who engage in criminal behaviors. This agreement will help fulfill this initiative by providing law enforcement services to developed and undeveloped areas of Forest Service land.


