<u>SUBJECT</u>: Approve an Agreement with Peninsula Messenger Service for

courier services

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a five year Agreement with Peninsula Messenger Service for courier service to all County departments with a term ending June 30, 2017.
- 2. Authorize the Chairman to sign four copies of the Agreement.

SUMMARY:

Courier service is provided under contract to all participating County departments. The courier service typically provides routine trips to over half of the approximately 160 facilities the County currently maintains. Since 1996, Peninsula Messenger Service has been the service provider for the County. The Agreement also allows for the modification to courier routes to accommodate vacancies and new sites to be serviced. The current contract expires on June 30, 2012. Services under the proposed agreement will be provided for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2017, with the option to extend for an additional year.

On March 13, 2012, General Services, with the help of the Purchasing Department, requested written proposals be submitted from companies that provide courier services in our area. A vendor conference was then held to allow these potential vendors the opportunity to clarify any questions. Of the three bids submitted, Peninsula Messenger Service had the highest overall score considered to be in the best interest of the County. Their bid was the lowest price, they have direct experience with the County, and they are a local firm.

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FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There are no net County costs to the General Fund. Courier services are paid for by the individual departments based upon their requirements for service.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Organizational Performance Initiative to continuously improve organizational effectiveness and fiscal stability. Approving the agreement with Peninsula Messenger Service helps fulfill this initiative by providing a quality service to departments efficiently.
