Approve an amendment to Agreement 24622 with Alternative

Services.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an amendment to Agreement 24622 with Alternative Services, Inc. in the amount of \$201,000 to provide Alcohol and Drug counseling services for the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment program from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.
- 2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the amendment to the Agreement.

SUMMARY:

Alternative Services, Inc. is the contracted agency providing services for the Residential Substance Abuse Treatment (RSAT) program. The original agreement was approved by the Board on June 29, 2010 and amended on June 7, 2011. This is the second amendment to the original agreement. The RSAT program is currently funded through a grant from the California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) for the period of October 1, 2010 – June 30, 2013.

The RSAT program is designed for male inmates with drug addiction problems who will be in custody for a minimum of 5 months. The targeted population is housed at the Men's Correctional Facility. A total of 64 beds have been designated for this program. Alternative Services provides counselors who address needs specific to recovery, parenting, anger management, and behavioral changes.

SUBJECT: Approve an amendment to Agreement 24622 with Alternative Services.

DATE: June 19, 2012

The original agreement was approved as to form by County Counsel and the Board of Supervisors on June 29, 2010. The only change from the original agreement, as amended to date, is changing the term of the agreement to July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The amount of the agreement is \$201,000. The general fund will be reimbursed from the Inmate Welfare Trust Fund/or through CalEMA grant funding, resulting in no Net County Cost. This expenditure will be included in the Sheriff's 2012/2013 operating budget.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The RSAT grant clearly is in alignment with the Safety and Security initiative of the Strategic Business Plan. More specifically it addresses the goal to "Provide facilities and resources for training and rehabilitation of criminal offenders." Counselors work with inmates on a full-time basis addressing the life skills and tools necessary for planned reentry into the communities.
