SUBJECT: Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture.

REQUEST(S):
That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for providing State subvention in the amount of \$900 to offset costs of providing soil treatment supervision, commodity treatment supervision and commodity and/ or soil sampling as required by the Nematode Control Program, retroactive to July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013. This Agreement is retroactive because of departmental staffing issues that delayed the process in bringing this contract forward.
2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed Agreement as of July 1, 2012, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the Agreement on that date.
3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the Agreement.

SUMMARY:
This agreement is intended to render State financial aid to the County for providing Nematode Control Program services and enforcement of nematode regulations. These services will protect the county's nursery industry by insuring that plant shipments are free of nematodes of concern, thus allowing them to continue shipping nursery plants out of Tulare county.

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County Counsel approved the Agreement as to form. The Agreement is between the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the County of Tulare for the term of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2012, and is for the amount of \$900. The Agreement includes a thirty day cancellation clause. The Agreement includes the following deviations from the County Contract Protocol.

- 1) The County is signing the Agreement first.
- 2) The County must indemnify the State.
- 3) The County may only terminate the Agreement for cause.
- 4) The State may terminate without cause upon thirty days written notice.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

This Agreement provides \$900 to the County of providing soil treatment supervision, commodity treatment supervision and commodity and/ or soil sampling as required by the Nematode Control Program. No additional net County cost to the General Fund. The costs and revenues are recurring for this program. The revenue and associated expenditures for this inspection program have been included in the Agricultural Commissioner's Fiscal Year 2012/2013 budget.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Economic Well-Being Initiative to promote economic development opportunities, effective growth management and a quality standard of living. The request to approve this Agreement will provide a continued funding source that will allow the continuation of a program that protects the County's agricultural economy.
