Declaration of Intent to Vacate a Portion of Camphor Avenue and a Portion of the Alley in Block 2 in Terra Bella

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Declare their intent to vacate a 450 foot portion of Camphor Avenue west of Road 237 and a 275 foot portion of the alley in Block 2 between Camphor Avenue and Avenue 95 in Terra Bella more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto;
- 2. Set a public hearing for April 2, 2013 at 9:30 A.M. or thereafter, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 2800 W. Burrel Avenue, Visalia to consider the vacation of the aforementioned roads; and
- 3. Direct the Resource Management Agency to publish and post the notice of public hearing in accordance with the Streets and Highways Code.

SUMMARY:

The portion of Camphor Avenue to be vacated is 60 feet in width and 450 feet in length, extending west from Road 237 to 150 feet east of Road 236. The portion of alley to be vacated is west of Road 237 in Block 2 of Terra Bella between Camphor Avenue and Avenue 95. It is 16 feet in width and 275 feet in length. The easterly 175 feet of this alley will not be vacated as not to affect access to privately owned parcels. These roads were dedicated to Tulare County by the map of Terra Bella in 1907.

DATE: March 5, 2013

Division to consolidate County Road Yard 5, which is divided by these portions of road, to reduce and prevent theft and vandalism of County property and equipment. Camphor Avenue separates the north yard from the south yard and the alley is located within the south yard and does not exist on the ground.

Camphor Avenue is within the Tulare County Maintained Mileage System as a minor road. The alley is non-maintained. As there are underlying lots created by the aforementioned Terra Bella map, an action to merge the underlying lots and the three Assessors Parcels which comprise Road Yard 5 shall be completed prior to the recordation of the resolution of the abandonment as to prevent the loss of access to the underlying lots. The County-wide Planning Branch of the Resource Management Agency has determined, through General Plan Referral 12-002 that the proposed vacation is not in conflict with the Tulare County General Plan.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no net cost to the County General Fund as a result of this action. There will be a minor decrease in Road Funds resulting from removal of this road from the Maintained Mileage System.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

Strategic Initiative 1: Safety and Security includes the goal of improving and maintaining adequate transportation infrastructure. This action promotes that goal by redirecting maintenance activities from unneeded alignments to active roadways. Strategic Initiative 2: Economic Well Being includes the goal of encouraging growth consistent with the County General Plan. This action corresponds with that goal by allowing self determination of private property use.

Exhibit A Legal Description

Those portions of Camphor Avenue and the alley in Block 2 per the Map of Terra Bella recorded December 3, 1907 in Volume 8 of Maps at Page 10 in the Office of the Recorder of the County of Tulare, State of California, more particularly described as follows;

Parcel 1

Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Block 2 thence West along the North line of said Block 2 a distance of 450 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 12 of said Block 2;

Thence North a distance of 60 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 29 of Block 1 of said Terra Bella map;

Thence East along the South line of said Block 1 a distance of 450 feet to the Southeast corner of said Block 1;

Thence South a distance of 60 feet to the point of beginning.

Parcel 2

Commencing for reference at the Northeast corner of said Block 2 thence South along the East line of said Block 2 a distance of 117 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 29 of said Block 2;


Thence West a distance of 175 feet along the South line of Lots 23 through 29 to the Southeast corner of Lot 22 of said Block 2 and the true point of beginning;


Thence West along the South line of Lots 12 through 22 a distance of 275 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 12 of said Block 2;

The Resource Management Agency Countywide Planning Division has reviewed the proposal and made the necessary investigations to determine if the project is in conformance with the General Plan. The proposal is for the vacation of a portion of Camphor Avenue, an approximately 450' east/west County right-of-way, located 150' east of the intersection Road 236 of Camphor Avenue to the intersection of Camphor Avenue and Road 237, in the community of Terra Bella. This request is also for vacation of a 275' east/west portion of an alley way 117' south of Camphor Avenue.

I have reviewed staff's findings and in accordance with Section 65402 of the Government Code, I find the above described proposal is in not in conflict with the adopted Tulare County General Plan.

TULARE COUNTY RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY STAFF REPORT GENERAL PLAN REFERRAL, GPR NO. 12-002 (VACATION OF ROAD)

PROPOSAL:

Request for vacation of a portion of Camphor Avenue, an approximately 450' east/west County right-of-way, located 150' east of the intersection Road 236 to Road 237, in the community of Terra Bella. This request is also for vacation of a 275' east/west portion of an alley way 117' south of Camphor Avenue.

LOCATION:

The section of road proposed to be vacated is an approximate 450' County right-of-way located 150' east of the intersection of Road 236 and Camphor Avenue, ending at Road 237, in the community of Terra Bella. The Alley way is located approximately 117' south of the above vacation. The roads can be found in Section 3, Township 23 South, Range 27 East of the Mount Diablo Base & Meridian.

FACTS AND FINDINGS:

General Plan Elements: Terra Bella and Ducor Community Plan

a. Land Use: There is no designation for roads.

b. Circulation: Local Road

c. Open Space: Urban Expansion

d. Urban Boundaries: Within the Terra Bella UDB

2. Zoning and Physical Use of the Land:

Site: Roads do not have zones. The section of road proposed to be vacated is an

approximate 450' County right-of-way located 150' east of the intersection of Road 236 and Camphor Avenue, ending at Road 237, in the community of Terra Bella. The

Alley way is located approximately 117' south of the above vacation.

Northside: Zoned M-1 (Light Industrial), and C-2 (General Commercial); Road Yard and

residences.

Westside:

Zoned M-1 (Light Industrial), and C-2 (General Commercial); commercial and vacant

lots.

Eastside:

Zoned R-2 (Two Family Residence), R-3 (Multiple Family, and C-2 (General

Commercial); single family dwellings.

Southside:

Zoned M-1 (Light Industrial), and C-2 (General Commerical); Road Yard and

commercial business.

3. <u>Flooding</u>:

According to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) dated June 16, 2009; Panel No. 1958, the road being vacated is located within Flood Zone X the area of 0.2% annual chance flood, areas of 1% chance of flood with average depths of less than 1 foot or with drainage areas less than 1 square mile, and areas protected by levees from 1% annual chance food. There are no potential impacts from flood.

4. Agricultural Preserves:

The site is not within an agricultural preserve.

5. Access:

Access will not be eliminated or restricted for any parcels as a result of the vacation of this portion of the county right of way. Parcels will still receive access from Camphor Avene and Road 237. The alley way is currently non existent and part of the current road yard.

6. Public Utilities:

All rights-of-way and easements of record for public utilities are reserved and accepted pursuant to Section 8340 of the Streets and Highways Code.

CEQA REQUIREMENTS:

The Engineering Division of the Tulare County Resource Management, as the lead agency, will prepare the environmental documents under the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Planning Branch Director find GPR 12-002 is not in conflict with the Tulare County General Plan as amended.
