**SUBJECT:** Authorize submission of a grant application

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the submission of a grant application to the Tulare Indian Gaming Local Benefit Committee for up to \$75,000 in funding under the SB 621 program.
2. Authorize the Sheriff's Department to submit the application on behalf of the Chairman.

**SUMMARY:**

In every year that funds were available, the Tule River Indian Gaming Local Benefit Committee has conducted a grant solicitation for proposals intended to mitigate the impacts of the operation of the Eagle Mountain Casino.

Today, the Sheriff's Department requests that your Board authorize submission of a grant application to address public safety impacts of the casino through funding of response by the Sheriff's air unit to appropriate incidents on the Reservation.

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The grant request of up to \$75,000 will pay for response by the Sheriff's air unit to calls for service on the Tule River Indian Reservation. There will be no net County costs to provide this surveillance.

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**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The Tulare County Strategic Business Plan includes a Security and Safety Initiative. The proposed program would address this initiative by, if funded, contributing to public safety at the Tule River Indian Reservation.
