Receive a presentation regarding an update of the activities of the Children's Services Network of Tulare County.

SUMMARY:

The Children's Services Network of Tulare County (CSN) is a multi-disciplinary collaborative made up of representatives and experts from education, juvenile justice, community based organizations, child welfare, faith based organizations, health providers, and mental health service providers. In 2006, when the Board of Supervisors approved the formation of this collaboration, it was founded with the vision of improving the well-being of children and families throughout Tulare County. Over the past 7 years, the CSN has engaged in various activities to make this vision a reality. Recent activities include launching a positive parenting media campaign, supporting the implementation of evidence-based practices, and implementing Tulare County's Child Protection Plan.

The CSN wishes to present an overview of these activities, as well as the initiatives and accomplishments of the collaborative.
