SUBJECT: Waiver of requirement for written competitive bids

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve the waiver of the requirements for written competitive bids and authorize the Purchasing Agent of Tulare County to purchase pre-mixed vertebrate pest control bait directly from the Kings County Agricultural Commissioner for resale to the citizens of Tulare County.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Agricultural Commissioner purchases pre-mixed vertebrate pest bait materials. These baits are then used to control pests which are detrimental to Tulare County Agriculture.

There are only three counties in the State of California, Kings, Alameda, and Yolo Counties, that are authorized to mix vertebrate bait to acceptable state standards, and then sell that bait to other counties.

The vertebrate bait is sold at actual cost as a courtesy to California Agriculturalists. There is no cost benefit in purchasing the bait from any one of the three counties that produce it. It is to the benefit of Tulare County to purchase the vertebrate bait from Kings County to have lower shipping rates, and more expedited turnaround time.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

These baits are sold to agriculturalists at cost in order to provide an economical and effective method of vertebrate pest control.
