RESOLUTION OF THE TULARE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION(S) FOR CALRECYCLE USED OIL PAYMENT PROGRAM FUNDS (OPP)

WHEREAS, Public ResourcesCode sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to administer various Grant Programs (grants) in furtherance of the state of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the Statethereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an Applicant's governing body to declare by Resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the TULARE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for the Used Oil Payment Program Cycle 4 (OPP4) for which TULARE COUNTY is eligible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CHAIRMAN OF THE TULARE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS or his/her designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of TULARE COUNTY all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grantfunds and implement the approved grant project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is effective for the term of the grant, July 9, 2013 through August 17, 2015.
