Approve an Agreement with the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Lake Kaweah Recreation Area.

#### REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- Approve an agreement with the United States Army Corps of Engineers for law enforcement services at Lake Kaweah Recreation Area, retroactive to April 5, 2013 through no later than September 02, 2013. The agreement is retroactive because it was just received from the United States Army Corps of Engineers.
- Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of April 5, 2013 and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign four copies of the agreement.

#### **SUMMARY:**

The Sheriff's Department has provided law enforcement patrol services to the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Lake Kaweah Recreation Area, for many years. The agreement includes one Deputy Sheriff and a patrol vehicle. Law enforcement service days shall be Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Federal holidays beginning April 26, 2013, and extending through September 02, 2013.

The primary duties of the Deputy Sheriff will include answering calls for service, routine patrol, response to emergency calls, and investigation of criminal offenses

occurring in the Corps recreation, administration and wildlife management areas.

### **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

Total revenue to be billed to the Corps of Engineers will not exceed \$33,000. Funds are included in the Sheriff Department's 2012/2013 budget and will be rolled-over to the 2013/2014 budget, as well. There is no net County cost.

#### LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative to effectively and fairly investigate arrest, prosecute, and punish individuals who engage in criminal behaviors. The agreement will help fulfill this initiative by providing normal, emergency and unanticipated enforcement of civil and criminal laws of the State and County of Tulare jurisdiction on Corps of Engineers' land.
