Approve renewal of license and maintenance with Northpointe for

COMPAS.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an agreement with Northpointe in an amount not to exceed \$17,820 for providing user licenses and maintenance support for COMPAS, retroactive to June 30, 2013 through June 29, 2014. This is retroactive due to inadvertent delays in negotiations. It was impracticable for the Board to take action before June 30, 2013 due to the time needed to process, prepare, and submit the agenda item.
- 2. Find that the Board had authority to enter into the proposed renewal as of June 30, 2013, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the renewal on that date.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the completed Agreement and accompanying documents on behalf of the County.

SUMMARY:

The Information & Communications Technology (ICT) Department is responsible for purchasing and maintaining the hardware and software contracts for the Information & Communications Technology assets of Tulare County, including but not limited to the mainframe computer, the data center servers, network infrastructure components and Storage Area Network (SAN).

COMPAS is a web based adult assessment tool that is currently interfaced with Caseload Explorer for Probation department.

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The agreement deviates from the County contract protocol, in that damages in litigation between the parties are limited to the amount of fees paid to the contractor.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The cost for renewal of license and maintenance is an amount not to exceed \$17,820. This is included in the FY 2013/14 budget to be paid from account number 071-090-2900-7043. No additional Net County Cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:
