Approval of an amendment to Agreement No 24777 with ABM

Industries

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 24777 with ABM Industries to extend the term of the agreement to December 31, 2014, for providing janitorial services in County facilities that are located outside of the County seat.
- 2. In accordance with Government Code section 31000, find that these outlying areas are remote from available county employee resources and that the County's economic interest is served by such a contract rather than by paying additional travel and subsistence expenses to existing county employees.
- 3. Authorize the Chairman to sign the amendment to Agreement No. 24777.

SUMMARY:

In the facilities that are located outside of the County seat, the General Services utilizes contracted services to meet the janitorial needs of the County personnel located within the facilities. The Request for Proposal process was utilized in August 2010 and on December 1, 2010, the County entered into Agreement No 24777 with ABM Industries to provide these services.

SUBJECT: Approval of an amendment to Agreement No 24777 with ABM Industries

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The Request for Proposal provided for a one-year renewal of this contract. The current contract is set to expire on December 31, 2013.

ABM Industries has demonstrated their ability to provide requested services to meet the County's janitorial needs at the service level requested by County.

The Amended Cost Schedule for the year renewal is attached as Exhibit "A-1" to the First Amendment to Agreement No. 24777.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The costs for these services to the General Fund have been included in the FY 13/14 budget for the Departments utilizing these services.
