SUBJECT: Approve Capital Asset purchase.

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a capital asset purchase to upgrade the Fire Department's 9-1-1 dispatch system with State funding allocated to the County in the amount of \$137,097.
- 2. Authorize the necessary budget adjustments per the attached AUD 308 (4/5ths vote required).
- 3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to waive the bid process and purchase directly from AT&T for the equipment, installation and services to upgrade the 9-1-1 dispatch system.
- 4. Authorize the Fire Chief to approve 9-1-1 dispatch scope of work and change orders related to the upgrade.

SUBJECT: Approve Capital Asset purchases.

SUMMARY:

The State of California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Office funds a 9-1-1 Computer System upgrade every five (5) years for Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) in California. The goal of the 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Office is to provide expedient telephone access to emergency services for all 9-1-1 callers and to assist PSAPs in the administration and funding of this life saving resource for California counties.

This upgrade will ensure that the County's 9-1-1 dispatchers have state-of-the-art dispatch equipment at their disposal to increase efficiency and effectiveness in emergency fire and public safety incidents so that the safety of human life, protection of property and civic welfare are provided to residents of Tulare County.

On February 1, 2012 the State of California awarded the statewide 9-1-1 dispatch system to AT&T, Master Purchase Agreement number 5-12-58-01, through request for proposal 1104-14. Master Purchase Agreements offer fair, reasonable pricing, are competitively bid and are only available to California State and Local Government Agencies.

The Tulare County Fire Department has been utilizing the AT&T 9-1-1 dispatch system since its inception. Additionally, the Tulare County Sheriff's Department uses the same 9-1-1 system through AT&T; upgraded through board resolution dated November 5, 2013. To maintain an accurate, effective, and consistent countywide 9-1-1 dispatch system, the Fire Department is requesting the Board to waive the bid process and purchase directly from AT&T.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The State of California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Office is allocating \$137,097 to the Tulare County Fire Department for the 9-1-1 computer system upgrade. The funding provides for the purchase of the upgrade of equipment, software, installation costs, training expense, and forty-eight (48) months of a service maintenance agreement on all existing and newly installed equipment and software. There is no Net County Cost.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security initiative which calls for planning and coordinating emergency preparedness and response. Approval to apply for requested grant will support efforts to obtain necessary safety equipment for emergency dispatching.
