SUBJECT: Authorization to Award Contract for Construction of Orosi High School Safe Routes to School Project

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve and award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Dawson-Mauldin Construction, Inc. of Huntington Beach, California, in the amount of \$195,331.60 for construction of Orosi High School Safe Routes to School Project;
2. Authorize the Chairman to sign the contract after review and approval as to form by County Counsel and upon receipt of certificates of insurance, bonds and evidence that the contractor possesses a valid State Contractors License; and
3. Allow funds for contingencies in the amount of \$19,533 (10%) to cover unexpected construction conditions.

SUMMARY:

The Orosi High School Safe Routes to School Project will construct curb, gutter and sidewalk along Road 126 (east side) between Miller Avenue and Avenue 419, which is in front of the Orosi High School campus in the community of Orosi. The purpose of the project is to provide school children a safe walking path to get to and from school.

The project was authorized for bid by the Board of Supervisors (Resolution No. 2014-0416) on June 17, 2014. Bids were opened on July 21, 2014 and a total of 6 bids were received with the following summarization:

The lowest responsive and responsible bidder was Dawson-Mauldin Construction, Inc of Huntington Beach, California with a bid of \$195,331.60.

The work is expected to begin in late August 2014 and be completed by October 2014.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no net cost to the County General Fund.

The total project cost is estimated to be \$246,864.60, which includes \$15,000 in preliminary engineering costs, \$195,331.60 in construction costs, \$19,533 in contingencies and \$17,000 in construction engineering costs.

State Safe Routes to School funding will be used to reimburse the project, which will be partially funded by Cutler-Orosi Unified School District and County Road Funds as follows:
